



SkySlope Forms FAQs

ACCESSING SKYSLOPE FORMS

Do we sign in with our CRMLS login credentials?

Users first sign into their CRMLS/REcore dashboard and then click the SkySlope tile. A SkySlope account will be automatically created if this is the user's first time accessing SkySlope. Once their account is created, the user will enter their NRDS I.D. to connect the account to the relevant documents.

Is there a fee for SkySlope Forms?

No, SkySlope Forms is the newest CRMLS benefit available at no additional cost (the SkySlope e-signature platform DigiSign is sold separately and not covered by CRMLS).

How much does DigiSign cost?

DigiSign is an affordable solution at \$64.99 per year, compared to DocuSign, which starts at \$120 annually for a Personal account.

If my brokerage doesn't utilize SkySlope, can I still use SkySlope Forms?

Yes, SkySlope Forms is a new user benefit available to all CRMLS users at no additional cost (the SkySlope e-signature platform DigiSign is sold separately and not covered by CRMLS).

SKYSLOPE FORMS VS. GLIDE/DOCUSIGN/ZIPFORM

What is the difference between SkySlope Forms, zipForm, and Glide?

Will SkySlope Forms replace Glide?

No, Glide is and will still be available as a CRMLS user benefit at no additional cost.

Will SkySlope Forms replace zipForm and/or DocuSign?

No, SkySlope Forms is an alternative product which can integrate with DocuSign or DigiSign as e-signature platforms.

TECHNOLOGY QUESTIONS

What is the difference between connecting DocuSign or DigiSign accounts?

DocuSign can be selected from the Preferences menu under the User Profile, however users will need to manage e-signatures separately through DocuSign. DigiSign is fully integrated with SkySlope Forms so users can manage forms and signatures in one place.

Do we sign in with our CRMLS login credentials?

No, users will create an account with an email address and chosen password and will log in with those credentials each time. Once an account is created, users will enter their NRDS I.D. to connect the account to the relevant documents.

Will the buyer's information automatically populate in SkySlope Forms?

Yes, if they are a saved contact. Contacts are initially entered into SkySlope Forms manually and then saved for future use. These saved contacts show as suggestions when a user starts typing a previously used name/value into a field.

FORMS AND TEMPLATES

Can I create form templates?

Yes, users can create their own templates in SkySlope Forms.

I work in multiple areas of California. Can I use SkySlope Forms in all areas?

Yes, users can search for and add all the libraries needed in their User Profile.

If I upload a PDF, can I then split the document into individual forms?

No, SkySlope Forms does not have the PDF split feature.

Can I add a form that is not available in any of the libraries?

Yes, users have the option to upload forms into their SkySlope Forms files.

Are C.A.R. forms included in the SkySlope Forms?

Yes, C.A.R. forms are among SkySlope Forms' library of documents.

When creating a template, if a form is updated by C.A.R. will the template automatically update with the new version of the form or does the template need to be recreated from scratch?

Forms added to templates are updated automatically in SkySlope Forms when they are updated by C.A.R. therefore users do not need to recreate the template.

FOR BROKERS

Is the Broker Edition of SkySlope included in what CRMLS is offering?

No, the Broker Edition of SkySlope is separate and not covered by CRMLS.
